SNB Research Conference – Monetary Policy Lessons from the Financial Crisis

25 – 26 September 2015, Zurich, Switzerland

The Swiss National Bank is organizing a research conference on the theme *Monetary Policy Lessons from the Financial Crisis*, to be held in Zurich on 25-26 September 2015. The conference provides a forum for discussing a wide range of theoretical and empirical issues related to monetary policy challenges.

Some of the topics that contributions to the conference might address include (but are not restricted to):

- non-conventional monetary policy
- mixing conventional and unconventional monetary policy
- monetary policy during and after the exit
- central banks' balance sheets issues
- the transmission mechanism and monetary policy with large excess reserves
- lessons from historical experiences
- challenges for small open economies
- monetary policy international spillovers
- monetary policy and financial stability
